


Welcome to OS Maps

If you're new to the OS Maps app, here's an introduction to the key features:





Home tab

Your personalised hub for all things OS Maps. This includes how-to guides, route recommendations and planning tools.

It also gives us a place to communicate with users about things like relevant seasonal safety messaging and being responsible in the outdoors.



Simplified menu bar

To help you get to what you want, quickly.



Routes tab

This is where you can find routes, or create your own routes to save and share. Use the snap to path feature to make plotting quick and easy. The menu icon in the top right lets you change route direction and route line styling.




Maps tab

This is the heart of it - the world class maps you know and love, anytime, anywhere.

Explore our aerial mapping or 3D view to get a better sense of the terrain. The menu in the top right gives you access to a toolbox with 'Locate Me' in for your digital compass and shareable grid reference, and the ability to show where your current offline map areas are.

Saved tab

View and manage your routes, offline and paper maps in one place. Save, bookmark or download routes, view offline maps and manage your digital paper maps.





Pins:


Introducing our newest OS Maps feature, Pins! Save your rendezvous point, drop a pin for your next camp site and remember where you parked your car. Share your favourite places with team mates and friends, and make the map your own.

Community Alerts:

A new tool used by the OS Maps community to highlight obstacles encountered in the outdoors such as blocked paths, overgrown vegetation and livestock in fields. Community Alerts is a real-time, footpath condition reporting tool that is a first of its kind for outdoor activities.


Getting started with OS Maps

Please follow the information on the next page to help you to redeem your premium subscription for OS Maps for free. Please read the instructions carefully as you will follow a process that is specific for Mountain Rescue Volunteers and must be followed for you to successfully access OS Maps Premium.

Before you start, make sure you have your team's OS Maps discount code. Every MREW team has its own unique code, and you won't be able to claim your free Premium subscription without it.

1 Create an account at osmaps.com

Your OS Maps account must use your Mountain Rescue email address. Visit osmaps.com, click 'log in', then select 'sign up now' and create your account using your Mountain Rescue email address.



2 Access the Mountain Rescue subscription

Claim your free subscription by clicking on 'Claim your free subscription' on [this page](#).



3 Claim your free subscription


Enter your details, and your team discount code in the discount code box, and click 'Apply'.

You'll be asked to enter valid payment details to complete checkout. You will not be charged, and the total will reduce to zero once the code is applied.

5 Use OS Maps on your devices

Your Premium subscription works across both mobile and desktop.

- Download the OS Maps app from the Apple App Store or Google Play Store
- Or access the desktop version at explore.osmaps.com

Your account will sync automatically between devices.

To save maps for offline use, go to **Saved or Offline Maps** and tap 'download' next to any map you want available on your device.

FAQs

How is OS Maps different for Mountain Rescue Volunteers?

The only difference between OS Maps for regular customers and Mountain Rescue England and Wales volunteers is the way in which MREW volunteers create an account- see the section titled "Using OS Maps" earlier in this Welcome Pack for more on how to create your MREW account.

The OS Maps product that Mountain Rescue Volunteers will access via the app (available on App Store or Google Play store) or desktop browser (available at explore.osmaps.com) does not have any difference in the functionality or features available to other consumers.

You are receiving access to a 12 Month non-recurring Premium Subscription to OS Maps available for MREW Volunteers at this [link](#) only. You will receive renewal details in due course.

Which terms and conditions apply to my use of OS Maps?

Mountain Rescue Volunteer use of OS Maps is governed by a separate Mountain Rescue End User Licence Agreement (MREW EULA) The MREW EULA outlines how you can use the app.

You can read the full MREW EULA at the end of this Welcome Pack. When you accept the OS terms and conditions online when creating your MREW OS Maps account, you will also be agreeing to the MREW EULA terms. Please therefore take time to familiarise yourself with the MREW EULA before creating an account.

The terms and conditions set out in the MREW EULA will always apply to you, if you are accessing and using OS Maps- whether you are using it in connection with your volunteering with Mountain Rescue England and Wales, or for your own personal use.

How can I set up my MREW account?

Your MREW team will have given you this Welcome Pack which contains information as to how you can create and access OS Maps as an MREW volunteer. If you experience any problems with the creation of your account please email partnerships@os.uk and provide details of your issue along with details of your MREW team. If you have any problems using the app once you have created your account please visit our [OS Maps Help Centre](#).

How can I use OS Maps?

As part of the MREW EULA you have access to use OS Maps for your voluntary work with Mountain Rescue England and Wales as well as your own personal use. We hope OS Maps will be useful for your work with your MREW team but also help facilitate your own adventures.

You can use OS Maps on your phone with the app available to download from the Google Play Store or App Store or on your desktop browser at explore.osmaps.com. You can ONLY redeem your subscription via osmaps.com on a special Mountain Rescue product once you have redeemed your subscription it will work on your phone and desktop.

We draw your attention to clauses 13 and 14 of the MREW EULA and suggest that you take the time to read this part in detail before sign up. Essentially, OS Maps has not been created specifically for MREW volunteers or MREW services, as such you must use your own judgment, skills and expertise when using OS Maps for MREW services and if any doubt, please defer to your MREW team leader.

I want to create routes - are there any restrictions?

If you are using OS Maps to create routes in connection with your Mountain Rescue voluntary work we ask that you make sure you mark your routes with an appropriate severity level. Please remember to mark the severity at a level appropriate for general users as opposed to a level which Mountain Rescue volunteers are accustomed to.

What can't I use OS Maps for?

You can not use your access to OS Maps for any commercial purposes outside of your voluntary work with Mountain Rescue. You can only use the app for voluntary work with your MREW team or your own personal use. You may not share your MREW team's redemption code outside of your MREW team and it can only be redeemed against your official Mountain Rescue email address and you must not share your login details with anyone else. You can find more details on how you can use OS Maps in the full MREW EULA included in this welcome pack.

You must not post any photos or other user generated content of any individuals taken whilst you are performing MREW voluntary work within OS Maps. This is to protect the privacy and / or safety of individuals that require MREW search and rescue services.

I already have an OS Account or OS Maps subscription, why do I need to create a separate one?

We recognise some of you may already have OS Accounts to our shop or existing OS Maps accounts, thank you for being part of the Ordnance Survey family. We do require you to set up a new account with your Mountain Rescue email address to access your premium OS Maps subscription. This helps us manage the partnership, and due to the way we permit Mountain Rescue volunteers to use OS Maps.

You can maintain your own account but to receive your access to OS Maps Premium through this partnership you will need to create a new account with your Mountain Rescue email address and redeem your premium subscription as outlined above.

Can I move routes in my personal OS Maps account to my Mountain Rescue OS Maps account?

If you have a personal OS Maps subscription and have already created routes in OS Maps you can move these across to your Mountain Rescue OS Maps account using the export and import function. You can export routes from OS Maps as a GPX file. To find out how to do that click [here](#).

What has happened to OS Locate?

OS Locate is being integrated into OS Maps in early 2024. For a brief period, from November 2023, OS Locate will not be available for download in the Google play store. This does not impact existing users of OS Locate, and it will not impact iOS users at all. We have been working closely with the MREW Product Committee and recognise the importance of a simple, intuitive 'locate me' feature that can give a grid reference location in as few clicks as possible.

MREW End User Licence Agreement (EULA) for OS Maps

We welcome all Mountain Rescue England & Wales (MREW) volunteers to OS Maps.

Please note that this end user licence agreement (the 'MREW EULA') is specifically drafted for MREW Permitted Users and it overrides the standard OS Maps End User Licence Agreement (the 'OS Maps EULA') which is displayed on the on the Ordnance Survey website and within the OS Maps App and web platform. This MREW EULA shall apply when you undertake any and all Mountain Rescue services in your role as volunteer. In the event you use OS Maps for personal, non-commercial use, outside of the Mountain Rescue services, the OS Maps EULA shall apply to such activity.

1. What is OS Maps?

OS Maps is a multi-award winning leisure mapping application, operated by Ordnance Survey, Great Britain's national mapping agency, which is made available both on the web and on mobile platforms. It provides online and offline access to Ordnance Survey mapping for the whole of Great Britain, together with detailed mapping for other world wide countries; routes for walking, cycling and running; points of interest; augmented reality and other fantastic features.

OS Maps (referred to in this MREW EULA simply as the / this Licensed App) is one of a number of different consumer apps (web and mobile), websites, social media sites and an online retail shop operated by Ordnance Survey. We refer to these collectively in this MREW EULA as the OS Sites and/or Services.

2. Introduction to this MREW EULA and its Terms and Conditions

OS and MREW have entered into an agreement which allows MREW volunteers to obtain a free subscription to the Licensed App for the purpose of using it in connection with MREW search and rescue services, MREW training and education programs and other related duties and activities.

This free subscription (which will be a 12 month non-recurring subscription) is only available to individuals who:

- are registered as Mountain Rescue volunteers
- volunteer within one of the 53 Mountain Rescue teams comprised of 49 MREW teams and 4 MREW Search Dogs team across England and Wales
- have been given an OS Maps redemption code.

In this MREW EULA:

- We refer to such individuals as MREW Permitted Users;
- We refer to the 12 month non-recurring subscription being given as an MREW Subscription;
- We refer to the redemption codes as the OS Maps Redemption Codes;
- We refer to the search and rescue services, training and education programs and other duties / activities undertaken by MREW volunteers as MREW Services; and
- We set out the terms and conditions which apply when using the Licensed App in connection with MREW Services.

MREW Permitted Users may also use the Licensed App for their own personal use. When using the Licensed App for personal, non-MREW use, the terms and conditions set out in the standard OS Maps EULA will apply (with the exception of clauses around payments and renewals).

We would also refer you to our Privacy Policy, Cookie Notice and Accessibility Statement. These are all summarised in paragraph 5a-c below).

We are legally obliged to pass on, or bring to users attention certain third party terms which may apply when you use the Licensed App. These are summarised in paragraph 5 d-e below.

Please review this MREW EULA (and the other documents we have referred to) very carefully. By redeeming an OS Maps redemption code for a Mountain Rescue subscription and/or accessing/using the licensed app in connection with mrew services you are agreeing to the terms and conditions set out in this MREW EULA (and other documents we have referred to). Please do not use this licensed app if you do not accept the terms and conditions set out in these documents.

3. Will the terms and conditions of this MREW EULA change at any time?

We may update this MREW EULA from time to time, as we add functionality to the Licensed App or for other reasons. Your continued use of the Licensed App constitutes your agreement to the then-current amended and updated MREW EULA. We may update this MREW EULA from time to time, as we add functionality to the Licensed App or for other reasons. Your continued use of the Licensed App constitutes your agreement to the then-current amended and updated MREW EULA.

4. Who are we?

This Licensed App, its content, and any related website pages are operated and managed by Ordnance Survey Leisure Limited, which is a subsidiary company of Ordnance Survey Limited, Great Britain's national mapping agency.

Ordnance Survey Leisure Limited is a company registered in England and Wales (registration number 06894550, and VAT number GB 973 4648 80) whose registered address is at Explorer House, Adanac Drive, SOUTHAMPTON, SO16 0AS.

Ordnance Survey Limited is a company registered in England and Wales (registration number 09121572, and VAT number GB 204 5274 37) whose registered address is also at Explorer House, Adanac Drive, SOUTHAMPTON, SO16 0AS.

Both Ordnance Survey Leisure Limited and Ordnance Survey Limited are referred to in this EULA as OS, we, us and/or our.

5. Privacy Policy, Cookies Notice, Accessibility Statement and Third Party Terms

In the introduction at paragraph 2 above, we referred to our [Privacy Policy](#) and [Cookies Notice](#) which apply to your use of the Licensed App, together with our [Accessibility Statement](#), and third party terms. Here is a summary of these documents/terms:

Our Privacy Policy

This Policy sets how we collect, process, use and look after any personal data that we collect from you, or that you provide to us, together with the choices you have about the information we may ask of you, when you use our OS Sites and/or Services.

Cookies Notice

This Notice provides information about how we use 'cookies' in our OS Sites and/or Services and how you can control and delete them.

'Cookies' are small text files that websites put on your computer to make visits quicker, easier and more relevant.

In addition to cookies, OS uses analytics and tracking software tools in its OS Sites and Services. Analytics and tracking software allows application providers to gain insights on how their users engage with the mobile / web app - for example, how they navigate through the app and what functionality and content is used. This enables app providers to make better decisions about services, improving performance and appropriate marketing. The tracking technology we use is Google Firebase and Adjust.

With the exception of cookies and analytics software which are strictly necessary for us to be able to deliver the Licensed App, tracking identifiers will only be placed onto your device if we obtain your consent, and data captured from such technology will only be processed in accordance with our Privacy Policy.

Accessibility Statement

Our Accessibility Statement provides information about browser support, screen resolution, document types, access keys, text sizing, images, forms and frames, scripting and links.

Third Party Terms

Certain mapping, routes and functionality within the Licensed App is made possible as a result of licensing arrangements we have with third parties and/or is licensed directly to you by third parties. We are legally obliged to by those third parties to include certain terms in this MREW EULA. These are set out in Schedule A of this EULA.

6. Access to the Licensed App and an MREW Subscription

The Licensed App and its various consumer subscriptions are generally made available to download / purchase via a desktop browser and from both the 'App Store' (for iOS devices) and the 'Google Play Store' (for android devices).

However an MREW Subscription can only be obtained via the desktop browser (at explore.osmaps.com)

Once you have obtained your MREW Subscription the Licensed App can be accessed and used free of charge on both a desktop browser or your mobile device.

Before applying for your MREW Subscription you will be required to register for an OS Account on the OS online shop.

To register as an MREW Permitted User (and thereby allow the OS Shop to recognise that you are going to be eligible for an MREW Subscription), you must create an OS account using your Mountain Rescue email address.

Once you have registered, you will be automatically directed to the 12 month non-recurring subscription option. Once added to your basket on the OS Shop, this will be shown as free of charge once you insert the OS Maps Redemption Code.

OS will provide Mountain Rescue with the OS Maps Redemption Codes, which they will then distribute to MREW Permitted Users.

We will send you an acceptance email, at which point a MREW Subscription will come into existence and you will be able to login and access your subscription.

7. Registrations and Passwords

Any username, password, email address or other piece of security information registered or provided by you as part of the registration and/or subscription process, must be treated as confidential and must not be disclosed to anyone.

If you know or suspect that anyone other than you knows your username, password, email address or other piece of security information then you should change your password immediately, and promptly notify us via our [Contact Us](#) webpage.

In the event that you forget or need to change your security login information please follow the relevant link provided in the Licensed App.

Please note that registering with the Licensed App does not automatically create an account with our other OS Sites and/or Services.

8. Details of MREW Subscription / other charges which could apply

a. Subscription

The MREW Subscription is a 12 month non-recurring subscription, which provides access to all the content and functionality of the Licensed App. Your access will end automatically at the end of that 12 month period. You will need to apply for a new MREW Subscription via a new OS Maps Redemption Code if you wish to continue accessing and using the Licensed App for the purposes of providing MREW Services.

b. Prices and payment

MREW Subscriptions are made available free of charge to MREW Permitted Users. As a result of the access and use of the Licensed App by your device, your wifi, internet, Bluetooth, mobile or other communication service provider may charge you additional fees for data usage, messaging and/or other wireless internet features, and you are solely responsible for such fees. It is your responsibility to confirm with your wireless internet service provider whether, and to what extent, any such fees apply to you.

9. Permitted Use of the Licensed App

This paragraph 9 sets out the licensing rights (and restrictions) which apply to MREW Permitted Users.

a. Licence to use the Licensed App

We grant you a non-exclusive, limited, non-transferable, non-sublicensable, revocable, worldwide licence to access and use the Licensed App and its content in connection with the provision of MREW Services and otherwise for your own personal, non-commercial use, in compliance with the terms of this MREW EULA.

You may download the Licensed App onto a maximum of 5 devices, but you may only cache data offline on 1 device concurrently.

b. Restrictions and Limitations on your use of the Licensed App

Except for Mountain Rescue Services, no commercial/non-personal use is permitted under this MREW EULA.

When using the Licensed App for MREW Services you may print, and make multiple copies or scans, and distribute the content of the Licensed App solely for use by other MREW Permitted Users and for persons attending MREW training courses and educational programs.

However, you may not:

- modify content in the Licensed App;
- other than as set out above, publish, print, sell, hire, lend, or sub-license any content for use by others;
- decipher, decompile, disassemble or reverse engineer any part of the Licensed App, except as permitted by law;
- bypass the built-in print function to increase the printable area of the content; or
- alter or remove any trade marks or the copyright or personal use notices appearing in/on the Licensed App or print-outs; or
- allow other persons (including MREW Permitted Users) to use Your MREW Subscription (MREW Permitted Users can be granted their own subscription to use);
- create User Generated Content which is made available to the public.

c. Mapping restricted to Great Britain

The Licensed App provides mapping content from outside Great Britain as a result of licensing arrangements with third parties. Some of these arrangements only permit use of the mapping for personal non-commercial use. As a consequence you are only permitted to use the mapping for great britain in connection with the MREW services.

You may use the mapping outside of great britain for your own personal, non commercial use, but using it for MREW services is expressly excluded from the licence being granted to you under an MREW subscription.

d. Procedure for sharing content from the Licensed App

The Licensed App includes a built-in sharing function which allows you to email a link, or upload a link to the internet (including to your social media sites), which then allows direct access to the Licensed App to others. You must not email, upload to the internet, or otherwise communicate any Licensed App content, for access or use by others, except by using this built in sharing functionality.

We reserve the right to immediately withdraw your linking permission on your account if you do not comply with this paragraph 9(c). Where we exercise this right, we will email you to inform you of our action and the reason why.

d. Embedding routes from the Licensed App

Where the Licensed App includes a built-in function that allows you to obtain a code snippet for a public route displayed on the mapping that you can copy and paste to your external website to embed and display that route on your external site (the Embedded Route), you may only display one Embedded Route per area of mapping.

You may only use the Embedded Routes or link to the Licensed App on your external site provided that:

- you do so in a way that is fair and legal and does not, nor is likely to, cause any damage to our reputation or take advantage of it;
- you do not misrepresent your relationship with us or suggest any form of association, approval or endorsement on our part where none exists;
- you do not do so in a way that is likely to give your users the impression that our content is yours;
- you do not create a frame or any other browser or border environment around the Licensed App;
- the site you link from does not contain content that is illegal or indecent, or infringes on any intellectual property rights or other rights;
- you ensure that for any Embedded Routes the Licensed App backdrop mapping, branding and copyright attribution statements provided by the Licensed App are displayed at all times and not removed, tampered with or replaced in any way.

We reserve the right to immediately suspend or disable any Embedded Routes on your account if you do not comply with this paragraph 9(d). Where we exercise this right, we will email you to inform you of our action and the reason why.

10. User Generated Content

The Licensed App allows you to create and share routes, information, data, photographs, comments and other content. Such content is referred to as User Generated Content.

This includes:

- User Generated Activity Data which are the tracks of your activities that are automatically generated for you and recorded by GPS if you select the 'Record Activity' feature. They show the path you took and the time you took for that activity.
- User Generated Routes which are the routes that you plot in the Licensed App (i.e. for your walks, cycling, rambles, horserides, runs or other activities), or the routes that are generated automatically for you from your User Generated Activity Data, including any photos, descriptions or tags you attach to these routes.

MREW Permitted Users must mark all User Generated Content with the corresponding severity level tagging. Please note that your User Generated Routes will be publicly accessible and you must therefore tag your User Generated Content at a severity level appropriate for general consumers other than MREW Permitted Users.

Please ensure that you either own or have appropriate permission to upload any User Generated Content before doing so.

a. Restrictions on the creation of User Generated Content

If you create or contribute User Generated Content, you must NOT include any of the following (Restricted Content):

- material which is illegal or promotes illegality;
- misleading information;
- material which is likely to cause harm to others;
- material which is threatening, abusive, offensive or indecent;
- defamatory material;
- material which infringes copyright or any other intellectual property rights of a third party;
- advertisements;
- personal information about you or a third party;
- material which contains a virus or other harmful component; or
- content which is made available to the public.

b. Our rights in respect of User Generated Content

We do not claim any ownership of any intellectual property rights which arise/subsist in your User Generated Content. However you grant us a royalty-free, worldwide, non exclusive, perpetual licence to display your User Generated Routes in the Licensed App and to use, store, reproduce, make derivative works of, and make your User Generated Content available to third parties, for any other purpose. (You agree to waive any moral rights subsisting in your User Generated Content).

User Generated Content which you mark as private will only be made available to you personally (for the duration of your subscription to the Licensed App) and not to other users.

User Generated Content created by Duke of Edinburgh Subscribers will not be made available to view or discover generally by other users who are not participating in the Duke of Edinburgh Award programme.

You will be responsible to us for any losses, expenses or other costs incurred by us which are caused by you deliberately contributing any Restricted Content to the Licensed App. Where permissible by law, we may disclose your identity and any other necessary information to any third party who claims that any User Generated Content submitted by you constitutes a violation of their intellectual property or other legal rights.

11. Takedown Procedure

OS is not responsible for any User Generated Content available on the Licensed App.

OS may, at any time, remove any unacceptable User Generated Content from the Licensed App, either in whole or in part (a Takedown). This will include (but without limitation) where we are notified or otherwise become aware or believe that any User Generated Content:

- includes any Restricted Content as set out in paragraph 10 above;
- breaches any applicable law, regulation, code of practice or is subject to an injunction or other action by a third party;
- is not in keeping with the purpose, themes or integrity of the Licensed App;
- is impacting the technical performance of the Licensed App;
- is generating complaints from other users or any third parties;
- should not be made available for other reasons; or
- has not been marked with a corresponding severity level tag and is available for viewing by the public.

Where we conduct a Takedown, we will email the user who created the User Generated Content to inform them of our action and the reason why.

12. Intellectual Property in the Licensed App

The copyright and all other intellectual property rights subsisting in the Licensed App and the material included within and published on the Licensed App, (including any mapping data but excluding your User Generated Content which is owned by you) are owned by OS and/or our licensors (including the Crown and other users of the Licensed App).

All of the brand, product and/or service names used in the Licensed App are trade marks of OS or their respective third party holders and/or are protected by other intellectual property rights. Please see a non-exhaustive list of [OS's trade marks](#). No such trade marks, brand, product or service names may be used without our express permission in writing.

13. Accuracy and Limitations of the digital content and functionality

The disclaimers and limitations of liability in this paragraph 13 do not apply to your non-excludable rights referred to in paragraph 15 below.

The licensed app delivers digital content which is created/owned by os; content which has been created by, supplied and licensed to us by third party providers; and user generated content.

OS Maps has been created as a consumer facing app, intended for use by individuals for their own personal, non commercial use in their leisure time. OS Maps has not been developed or changed to meet the individual requirements of mountain rescue or MREW permitted users.

OS Maps and the content and functionality made available on OS Maps will be used by Mountain Rescue and the MREW permitted users in connection with MREW services entirely at MREW and the mrew permitted users own risk.

The content available in OS Maps is not intended to amount to instructions or formal advice on risk assessment or health and safety, on which Mountain Rescue and/or MREW permitted users should rely. Mountain Rescue and its mrew permitted users must always exercise their own knowledge, skills, MREW training and judgment when OS Maps and its content and functionality.

OS makes no representations, warranties or guarantees (express or implied) to Mountain Rescue and/or MREW permitted users regarding availability, accuracy, completeness or currency of OS Maps and its contents and functionality, nor its suitability for use in the Mountain Rescue services or for any particular purpose.

We do not check the accuracy, feasibility or safety of any user generated routes or any routes supplied by third parties. The views expressed in user generated content or any routes supplied by third parties are those of individual contributors and not necessarily those of os. It is possible that the information found in user generated content and routes supplied by third parties contains errors, or is incomplete, or out of date.

The content in the Licensed App is not intended to replace the information presented in the physical environment such as local hazard signage or the highway code and the licensed app should not be relied on when this is in conflict.

Coordinates are the coordinates of the destination of any route (whether on a map and/or through a description in words) where the route is created by the Licensed App in response to a request by you. Where the Licensed App enables you to do so, you may download these coordinates. However we cannot guarantee and we shall have no obligation to ensure that the Licensed App is configured to enable you to download the coordinates.

We cannot guarantee the ongoing supply of any content sourced from third parties, including certain points of interest and leisure route information, and we may alter the third party content we provide via the Licensed App at any time.

14. Availability of the Licensed App

We cannot guarantee that the Licensed App will always be available or uninterrupted. We will always try to notify users of downtime in advance. However, we may have to suspend, withdraw, discontinue or change all or any part of the Licensed App without notice where it is necessary to do so on an urgent basis, for example to comply with a legal requirement, or to conduct emergency maintenance to protect the security and integrity of the Licensed App.

In addition to the above, as we are constantly enhancing the Licensed App we reserve the right to suspend access in order to make technical adjustments, fix errors, improve features or make minor changes from time to time.

Some functionality of the licensed app requires wifi, internet, bluetooth and/or gps coverage. We do not guarantee that the Licensed App is available or accessible on all devices, wifi, internet, bluetooth, mobile or other connections. You are responsible for ensuring that your device meets the minimum operating requirements.

We cannot guarantee that the Licensed App, or the servers that makes it available are free from viruses or bugs. It is your responsibility to implement any procedures and virus checks to satisfy your own requirements.

15. Responsibility for loss or damage suffered

16. Bringing our contractual relationship with each other to an end - Suspension / Cancellation/ Termination

a. **Our right to terminate this MREW EULA**

If the agreement between OS and MREW which provides for the MREW Subscriptions expires or is terminated for any reason whatsoever, all MREW Subscriptions will cease on that date and you will no longer have access to the Licensed App. (In such circumstances, if You wished to continue using the Licensed App for Your own personal use, You would need to apply for your own subscription through the OS Shop.

OS monitors use of the Licensed App. and we reserve the right to suspend, cancel and/or terminate your MREW Subscription and/or use of the Licensed App, on written notice to you, at any time if we reasonably suspect that you have failed to comply with any of the terms and conditions set out in this MREW EULA.
