

## QUESTIONS

### Easy

- How many different types of tourist and leisure symbol, marked in blue, can you count on the map?
- How many streets end in 'Lane' (which is abbreviated to 'La' on this map)?

### Medium

- In what field might you expect witches to gather?
- Which street has a name that translates to 'good agreement'?

### Tricky

- How many routes can you find from Swanage Hospital to Harrow House International College that only involve changing the name of the road you're on a total of four times? (Don't count roads you cross directly over towards your total.)
- What word do the following four routes spell out?
  - Head south from the southernmost church without a tower to the end of the road by the school, then turn around and turn right, following the road to the hospital
  - Head west from the easternmost church along the A road, turning left after 175 metres. Take the first left, and at the end of the road turn around and drive back along the road. Then turn left and again left, stopping when the road changes name
  - Start on the road to the east of the church nearest the Town Hall, then follow the road south and around the corner until you reach the first turn-off
  - Enter the map area from the south, travelling to the end of a road named after a well-known Isaac. Take the first three right-hand turns and keep going until the end of the road

### Challenging

- Which words on the map are being cryptically described here?
  - Geometric figure is old-fashioned and boring
  - Sullivan's partner tangles girl with bet
- Can you find two roads with identical names, except that one has an extra letter inserted relative to the other – but none of its other letters rearranged? Ignore the road ending ('Street', 'Road', etc.) for the purposes of this question.
